Just a friendly reminder that your 2025 PLAA dues of \$750 were due September 1, 2024 per PLAA Bylaws. December 1, 2024, was the end of grace period before penalties and interest kick in. If you missed that deadline, please keep in mind that late fees and interest can add up fast! Property

owners with outstanding balances of \$1,000 or more will be subject to liens, so let's get those balances cleared up! As discussed during the recent Annual Members Meeting in August, the Board of Trustees is currently collaborating with the law firm Weltman, Weinberg & Reis and anticipates being fully engaged with them by early April. With their assistance, we aim to recover outstanding PLAA dues owed to the community.
